

This DVD was created with five different audio options:

- **SPLIT TRAX ACCOMPANIMENT**
- **SPLIT CLICK ACCOMPANIMENT**
- **SPLIT NARRATION ACCOMPANIMENT (WHEN APPLICABLE)**
- **STEREO TRAX ACCOMPANIMENT**
- **CHORAL DEMONSTRATION/LISTENING**



SPLIT TRAX ACCOMPANIMENT

This is the default setting for this DVD. In other words, if you insert this DVD into your player and do not choose a particular audio option, it will choose split trax for you automatically. There is a left and right channel with orchestra on the left and choir vocals on the right. Use this option exactly the same way you would a standard split trax CD: turn the left channel up and down to control the orchestra and the right channel up and down to control choir reinforcement vocals, if you decide to use them.

SPLIT CLICK ACCOMPANIMENT

This option functions like a normal split trax, however, there is click and count on the right side and the instrumental trax on the left. This option is best used when you are performing with your band and/or orchestra, but you still want to use the DVD visuals. Send the click trax and little pre-recorded orchestra to your band members and conductor using headphones. This allows them to lock into the trax and stay right with the visuals on the DVD, even though the music your congregation hears is actually being created live with your musicians.

SPLIT NARRATION ACCOMPANIMENT (WHEN APPLICABLE)

This option functions exactly like the split trax accompaniment, the only exception being, there is narration and instrumental trax on the right side with choir reinforcement vocals on the left.

STEREO TRAX ACCOMPANIMENT

This option functions like a standard stereo accompaniment trax. There are no choir vocals, solos or narration. It is just stereo instrumental orchestra.

CHORAL DEMONSTRATION/LISTENING

The audio for this option is identical to the Listening CD. Use this option for rehearsal or any other setting where a full demonstration is necessary.

LYRICS ON and LYRICS OFF: Many of the songs on the DVD have the actual song lyrics as a part of the visual, but when they do not, we have provided an option for the lyrics to be projected along the bottom of the screen. You must make this choice when you are initially choosing an audio version.

REHEARSAL POINTS: In the same fashion that a CD Accompaniment Trax contains individual CD points for rehearsal within each song, this DVD has the same feature. Please refer to the print for exact rehearsal locations and then select the corresponding rehearsal point on the DVD menu. These points are available within any of the audio options.
